# FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Revision 2 – Trailer Park Amendment

## Final Instructions

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Thank you for your entry, your start number is as per the provisional entry list, although this may be subject to change. A final list will be displayed at noise check.

Fuel will be available after 65 miles following which there will be 25min Time Recovery.

If you require fuel before the rally starts, fuel can be obtained from the following garages in/around Abergavenny:

### Scrutineering

There will be no inspection of light covers at scrutineering although please see below:

Due to the event traversing mileage in the West Mercian Police area, auxiliary spotlights will not be permitted between MC3 (Petrol out) and SS7 (totalling approx 20 miles). During this section of route auxiliary spot lights must either be removed or switched off and covered with solid, well fitted opaque covers. Should a cover become lost or damaged, the spot light must be removed immediately. The penalty for contravening is exclusion.

This may appear harsh but the use of covers opposed to a complete ban has been negotiated with the RLO, so please help us to repay the faith by being vigilant.

Only E marked tyres will be Permitted to be used. All tyres presented at scrutineering will be marked and may checked at the Halfway Halt and Damage Control. In accordance with L6, permission has been applied for to allow competitors to use Yokohama AO21, A048 and A032 tyres manufactured before 1st November 2014, which is shown on the sidewall as 4314. Tyres manufactured after this date or with an ineligible manufacturing date are prohibited.

### Route Information

#### 1. ROUTE INFORMATION

After successfully signing-on entrants will be supplied with a rally pack. Route will be issued at MC0. Route will be defined by Time controls, Passage controls, Route checks, Giveways and via points - by means of six figure map references. 3 meter triangle diagrams and arrows where specified in the route card also define route. The information will enable competitors to comply with **R.2.3.2, R9.1-R9.3.2 and R14.1-R14.1.8**. All organisers' mileage shall be deemed to be correct, having been established in accordance with **R6.2 – R6.2.9**. All organisers' road signs are mandatory.

***Due to spectator related PR problems, ANY competitor found to be divulging route information to non-competitors will be EXCLUDED.***

### Marshals / Controls

Remember: **No Marshal - No Start**. Please ensure your marshals are equipped with map 161, a torch, hammer, pen, clipboard and reflective jacket.

Controls may be pre-booked by phoning David Powell on 07969 455256 - between 19:00 and 21:00 up until Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> October. Marshals with pre-booked controls must sign on by 20:30 or their reservation will be forfeited.

Please remind your marshal of the following regulation, which WILL be enforced:

Failure to provide a marshal, or their failure to man their allocated control according to the regulations of the event and other written instructions, for its duration, will result in exclusion of that crew and no refund of entry fee. Failure to open their control at the allotted time, **or a marshal found to give an inaccurate time to ANY competitor, will result in the crew the marshal has signed on for being penalised 1 Fail.**

In the event that a marshal does not make it to their post, the control will be deemed as a 'Route Check' (Code board) which must be recorded and your Passage card, and signed for at the following manned control. Any route check will be preceded by a 'C' board and will comply with MSA and WAMC championship regulations.

## Documentation / Signing On

Please remember your MSA competition licence, club membership cards and any relevant championship cards / insurance details. Any competitor not signed on by **21:15** will be excluded and have their place offered to a reserve.

There will be a competitors briefing at 21:45 all competitors must attend. You will be able to collect your route from MC0 (signing-on desk) at 22:15 plus your start number.

Novices may collect their route 30mins prior to their scheduled MC0 time.

Your start time at MC1 (exit of start car park) is 23:45 plus your start number.

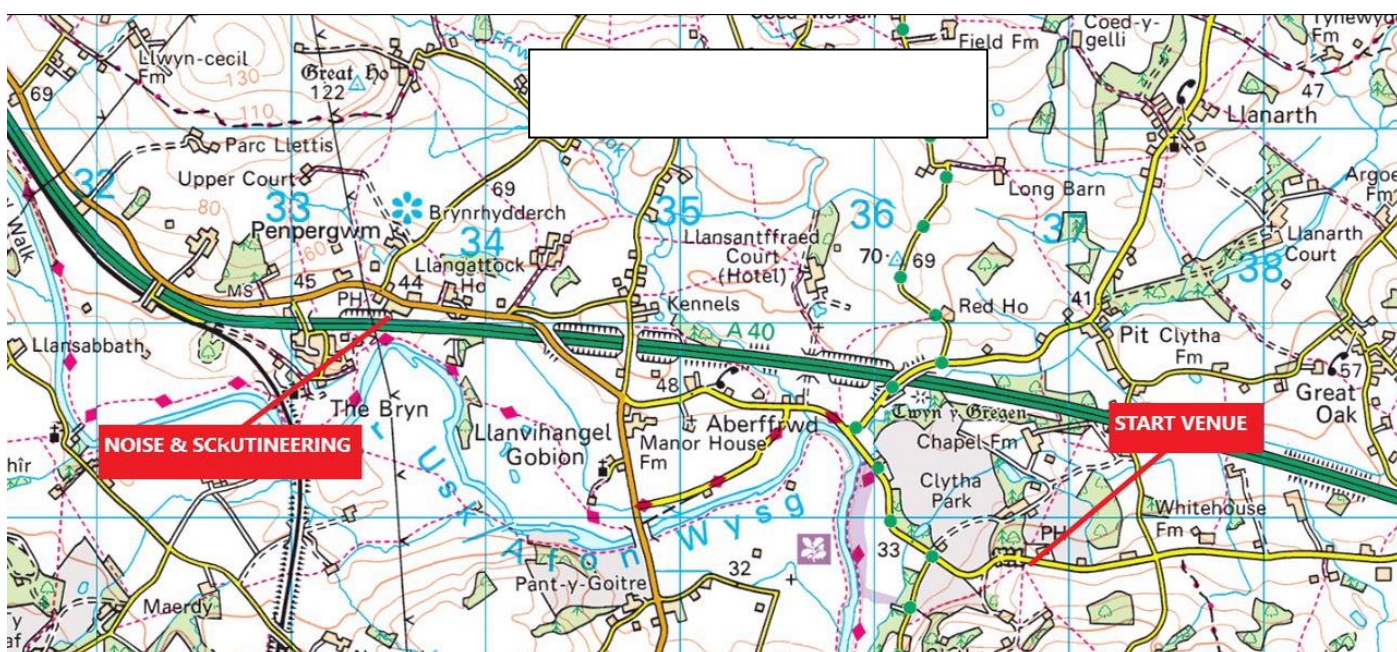
For we have the use of a Recovery vehicle on the night, Stefan Skinner Tel No: 07540 481923. Please make a note of the number in case you need assistance.
