Thank you for your entry, your start number is as per the provisional entry list, although this may be subject to change. A final list will be displayed at noise check. Only OS Map 161 is required for the event.

Trailers / Fuel

Parking for trailers is available at the noise / scrutineering venue, although is non secure and is at competitors own risk. Location attached

If you require fuel before the rally starts, fuel can be obtained from the following garages in/around Abergavenny:
ESSO: 301.5 144 BP: 293 145 Waitrose: 292 137

Fuel will be available after 65 miles following which there will be 30min Time Recovery.

Scrutineering

Noise & Scrutineering will open at 17:30 and close at 20:30. Details of their location are attached.

Due to the event traversing mileage in the West Mercian Police area, auxiliary spotlights will not be permitted between control point DSO B and SS3 (totalling approx 20 miles). During this section of route auxiliary spot lights must either be removed or switched off and covered with solid, well fitted opaque covers. Should a cover become lost or damaged, the spot light must be removed immediately. The penalty for contravening is **exclusion**.

This may appear harsh but the use of covers opposed to a complete ban has been negotiated with the RLO, so please help us to repay the faith by being vigilant. You will be able to make a decision on where you chose to fit your covers / remove lights once you have your route card.

Only E marked tyres will be permitted. All tyres presented at scrutineering may be marked and checked throughout the event on neutral sections and or the Damage Control. As per L3.2 Yokohama A021 tyres manufactured before 1st November 2014, (which is shown on the sidewall as 4314) are permitted, although tyres manufactured after this date or with an ineligible manufacturing date are prohibited.

Route Information

*Due to spectator related PR problems, ANY competitor found to be divulging route information to non-competitors will be **EXCLUDED**.*

Marshals / Controls

Remember: **No Marshal - No Start**. Please ensure your marshals are equipped with map 161, a torch, hammer, pen, clipboard and reflective jacket.

Controls may be pre-booked by phoning Gerwyn Barry on 07525 252101 - between 19:00 and 21:00 up until Thursday 10th October. Marshals with pre-booked controls must sign on by 19:00 on Saturday 12th or their reservation will be forfeited.

Please remind your marshal of the following regulation as per SR's:

Failure to provide a marshal, or their failure to man their allocated control according to the regulations of the event and other written instructions, for its duration, will result in exclusion of that crew and no refund of entry fee. Failure to open their control at the allotted time, **or a marshal found to give an inaccurate time to ANY competitor, will result in the crew the marshal has signed on for being penalised 1 Fail.**

Documentation / Signing On

Please remember your MSA competition licence, club membership cards and any relevant championship cards / insurance details. Any competitor not signed on by **20:45** will be excluded and have their place offered to a reserve.

There will be a competitors briefing at **21:15**, all competitors must attend. Route will be available for collection at MC0 (located at the signing-on desk) at **21:45** plus your start number.

Novices may collect their route 30mins prior to their scheduled MC0 time.

Your start time at MC1 (exit of start car park) is **23:05** plus your start number.

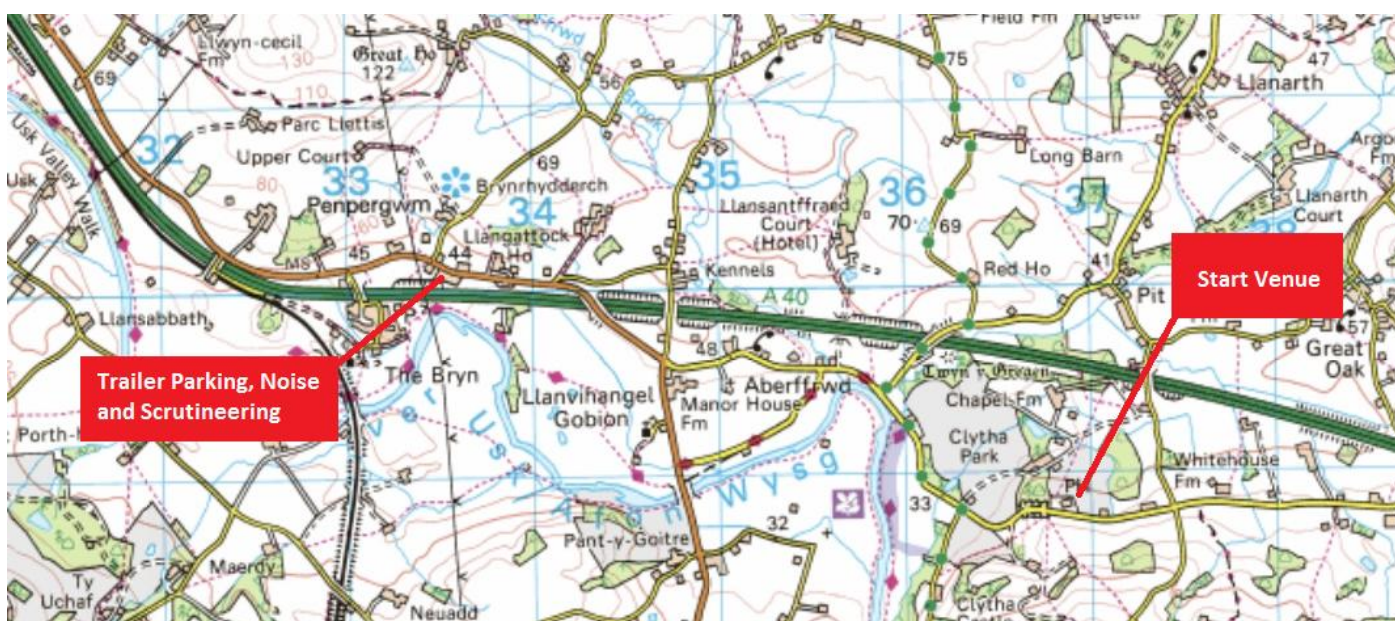

Trailer Parking, Noise & Scrutineering:

Ref: 335 101 'Hockey Automotive Group' open from 17:30 until 20:30, one way system which will be arrowed, below diagram for reference:
